General Information

Carrot River is located in North Eastern Saskatchewan, close to the Manitoba border. It is situated between the Cumberland Delta and the Pasquia Hills. Our area consists of prairie farmland bordering the 2nd highest elevation in Saskatchewan.

We have a variety of big game species including moose, elk, black bear, deer, a variety of fur bearing animals and water fowl.

The main industries surrounding Carrot River include grain/livestock farming, logging/sawmill operations, and a peat moss plant.

Within 30 minutes, Tobin Lake boasts World Class Walleye and Northern Pike fishing to enjoy year round.

Pasquia Regional Park located minutes from town contains an outdoor swimming pool, excellent camping facilities, and a Top 10 rated 9-hole grass green Golf Course. This park is also the home of "BIG BERT", the remains found of a prehistoric crocodile which has proven to be a large Tourist Attraction.

own and operate Lost Creek Outfitters which is situated 23½ miles east of Carrot River, SK at the base of the Pasquia Hills Provincial Forest. We are a 3.5 hour drive from the Saskatoon airport. Our camp lies between two creeks providing quiet serenity where wildlife wander through the yard to munch on the fruit in the orchard while we sit at the kitchen table, enjoying bird-watching through the picture window. Approximately 100,000 acres of prime trophy Whitetail habitat await you. Ground blinds and tree stands ensure a comfortable hunt.

Our new Lodge provides all the comforts of home including 2 full bathrooms and 4 spacious bedrooms complete with cozy flannel bedding. We have an impressive "game room" complete with a gas fireplace & Big Screen Satellite TV where you can relax and unwind.

We take great pride in our area and the fact that our guides are enthusiastic, personable, knowledgeable, bush-wise and awesome hunters themselves. Angella is in charge of your accommodations and delicious home-cooked meals. Here at Lost Creek . . . hunting is not a job . . . it's our way of Life!

Suggestions:

- We can arrange transportation from Saskatoon to camp and return upon request for a fee of \$100 USD each way. (\$200 round trip) for each person (Pd to Outfitter - Max. charge \$600 one way for the vehicle).
- (You may wish to rent a vehicle to have transportation during your stay.)
- Archery, Muzzle Loader and Rifle Hunts are available to you. Plan for arrival on Sunday with hunts to commence Monday through Saturday. The majority of Rifle deer hunts are during the month of November where temperatures can drop to -40° C. Following is a list of suggested items to bring:

- Rain Suit and/or Gore Tex
- Long underwear/wool socks
- Winter Boots (up to -80° C)
- Hunting Suit (solid white)
- Insulated Gloves/Hat (Hat to be Red, Orange or Yellow)

- Camouflage
- Preferred snacks & beverages
- Thermos
- Tree Stand Belt (mandatory)
